

Luca obtained his MSci in Chemistry from Imperial College London in 2009, before moving to the University of Cambridge to carry out a PhD on the Cancer Research UK programme in medicinal chemistry and chemical biology, under the supervision of Profs David Spring and Ashok Venkitaraman. He moved to the Max Planck Institute of Molecular Physiology in 2014, where he was first an Alexander von Humboldt postdoctoral fellow and then a project leader in the group of Prof. Herbert Waldmann. In November 2017 he moved to the Technical University of Denmark to start his independent research group at the Department of Chemistry, where he was first an assistant professor, and then an associate professor since April 2021. His group is interested in the study of cholesterol-mediated processes through the development of selective chemical probes. Luca was awarded the Hallas Møller Emerging Investigator Grant by the Novo Nordisk Foundation and the ERC Starting Grant (2021).
