

Alastair Lennox obtained his master of chemistry from the University of Manchester in 2008. He then moved to the group of Prof. Guy Lloyd-Jones at the University of Bristol, where he completed his PhD degree in 2013, with a thesis on organotrifluoroborate preparation, coupling and hydrolysis. From 2014 to 2015, he was an Alexander von Humboldt postdoctoral fellow in the group of Prof. Matthias Beller at the Leibniz Institute for Catalysis (LIKAT) where he worked on homo- and heterogeneous photocatalytic water reduction. He then joined the group of Prof. Shannon Stahl at the University of Wisconsin where he developed electrochemical catalytic reactions in collaboration with AbbVie. Since 2018, he is a Royal Society University Research Fellow at the University of Bristol.
